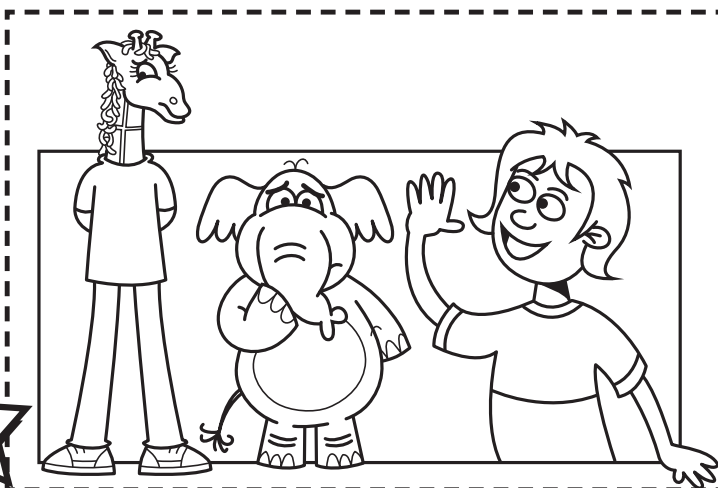
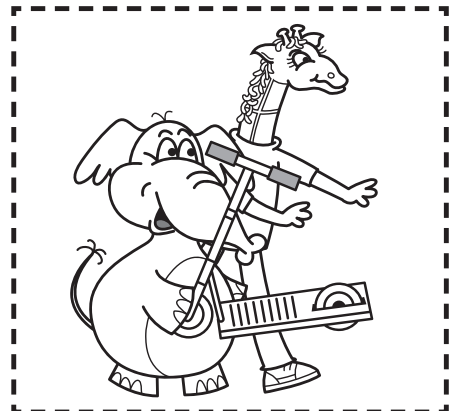
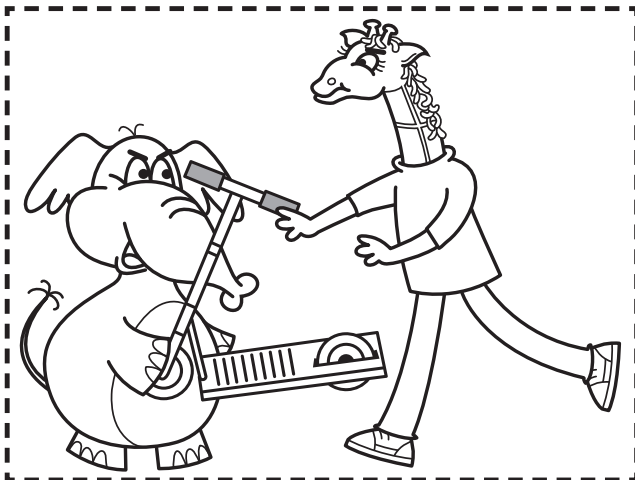
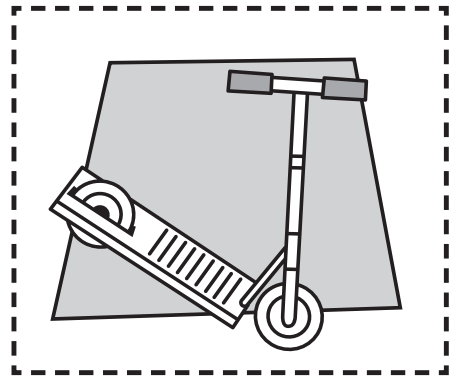


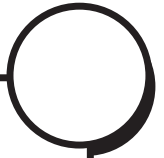
Taking Turns
