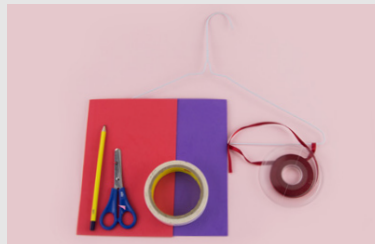


Valentine's Day Heart Mobile

Supplies

- Red or pink foam sheets (self-adhesive is best)
- Plastic or metal coat hanger
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape



- Acrylic jewels, foil or glitter



1 First, use a pencil to draw different sized hearts onto your foam. Then lay your foam on top of another sheet of foam so that you can cut out pairs of hearts that match.



4 Now take the corresponding hearts you have left and match them to the hearts which you have already attached. Stick each heart with its partner so that the ribbon is sandwiched in between the foam.



2 Next, take your coat hanger and cut some lengths of ribbon which will be spaced along the bottom edge of your coat hanger. Using double-sided tape, attach one end of each length of ribbon to the coat hanger.



5 Use your scissors to snip off any excess ribbon and you will be left with a beautiful heart mobile.



3 Lay your coat hanger flat with the ribbons pulled straight. Arrange one half of your hearts along the ribbons with the ribbons running over the top of them. Once you are happy with how your mobile looks, either remove the paper covering the adhesive on your hearts or use double-sided tape to stick your hearts firmly to the ribbon.



6 If you would like to add some sparkle then use some acrylic jewels, foil, glitter, or whatever you have available.

Valentine's Day Heart Mobile



Supplies

- Red or pink foam sheets
- Acrylic jewels, foil or glitter
- Plastic or metal coat hanger
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape





Step 1. First, use a pencil to draw different sized hearts onto your foam. Then lay your foam on top of another sheet of foam so that you can cut out pairs of hearts that match.



Step 2. Next, take your coat hanger and cut some lengths of ribbon which will be spaced along the bottom edge of your coat hanger. Using double-sided tape, attach one end of each length of ribbon to the coat hanger.



Step 3.

Lay your coat hanger flat with the ribbons pulled straight. Arrange one half of your hearts along the ribbons with the ribbons running over the top of them. Once you are happy with how your mobile looks, either remove the paper covering the adhesive on your hearts or use double-sided tape to stick your hearts firmly to the ribbon.



Step 4. Now take the corresponding hearts you have left and match them to the hearts which you have already attached. Stick each heart with its partner so that the ribbon is sandwiched in between the foam.



Step 5. Use your scissors to snip off any excess ribbon and you will be left with a beautiful heart mobile.



Step 6. If you would like to add some sparkle then use some acrylic jewels, foil, glitter, or whatever you have available.
