**Phonics-** Live lesson at 10am. **Please use the Teams link emailed to you.**

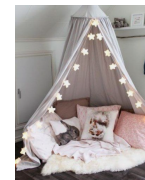
**Literacy-** Can you research and make a list of animals that live in the Arctic and Antarctic. Here are two videos to find out more about polar bears and penguins:
