Is it possible to make a circle or semi circle, why not?

You could challenge yourself and try to make an octagon (8) or decagon (10)

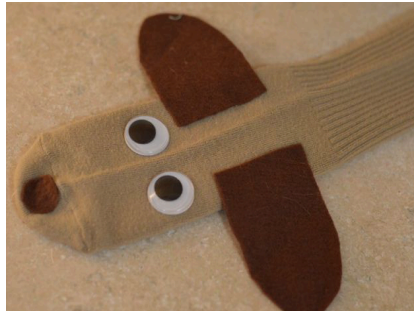


You might want to play this game to see how quickly you can match the shapes:
