

Thursday 11th February Year R - Home Learning

PE- All you need is a dice and your best animal moves for your exercise today. Each time you roll a different number you'll need to move as that animal. 1= dog, 2=cat, 3=mouse, 4= rabbit, 5= snake, 6= chicken

If you want to challenge yourself, you could use 2 dice and add the amounts together, can you think of other animals for 7,8,9,10,11 and 12?

Literacy- Pick a picture to match the word you read on screen. Select phase 3 digraphs to practise the special friends we have been learning. *Note that 'oa' and 'ow- as in cow' are not sounds that we have covered so you will need to read these to your child.*
