Maths- Exploring ways to make 10 using a 10 grid.


You will need your 10 grid (on the class webpage) & 10 coins (all the same amount).


Throw all the coins and see how many land heads and how many tails.

Place the coins on your grid all the heads, then all the tails.

Keep playing to see the different ways your 10 grid will look.

You could record your findings e.g 7+3=10





A few weeks ago there was a game throwing 5 objects into a bucket/hoop target. You can repeat this with 10 items and record how many where in and how many were out. Can you show your scores on a 10 frame?

For example, on the frame above shows I threw 4 in the bucket, and 6 out.
