Set the timer again and see how quickly you can put them back, were you quicker this time?

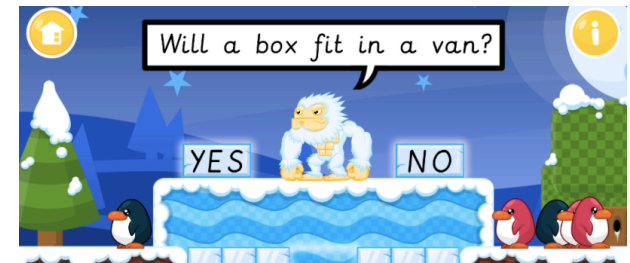
You could try this again with other items or some from your garden. You could help write the list.
