**Phonics-** Live reading and writing session at 10am.

Literacy – Be a word detective (you might need a badge, notebook or magnifying glass). Grown-ups please hide the 10 words around your house/ room for the children to find (the words are on the class webpage and can be printed out and cut up or handwritten yourself- please use lowercase not capitals). Children are to find them, say them (using special friends and Fred talk) and write them down. Can you find and underline all the special friends?



Maths- Watch the 6 minute lesson on combining 2 groups, it is the 4<sup>th</sup> video down called 'Combining 2 groups'.

How many spots do the dominoes have on each side? How many do they have altogether?

You can then complete the activity about adding the spots on the dominoes. Have a go at writing the addition sum under each one. If you have your own set of dominoes at home you could play a game and continue adding them. What is the most or fewest spots you could get on your domino?

**Craft**- If you are at the police station, you might be asked to give your fingerprints. Everyone's fingerprints are slightly different, so the police can tell who the person is by looking at their fingerprints.

Can you use your fingerprints to create a fingerprint picture?

You could also practise making your fingerprints in play dough or with talc on dark paper.
