Literacy- Write about a pet you have at home or one in your family. What does it look like, like to eat, how do you care for it, what does it need? You could write about a favourite pet animal or cuddly pet if you don't have an animal at home.

Evie, the grey and white cat



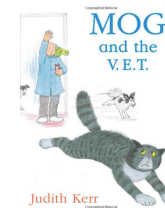
Maths- Counting scoops (lets pretend it's animal feed!), thinking about capacity. You will see the activity on the class blog. Choose some different sized containers and count the number of scoops it takes to fill each one. You could keep a record and make estimates as you did with the liquid measuring. You could use soil, flour, pet food, sand to fill your containers.

Imaginative role play- Can you set up your own vets at home? Do you have some cuddly animal toys that need looking after? You can check how heavy they are, groom them, give them their vaccinations and a check-up. You might have an emergency to sort out too. Don't forget to check your appointment book and take calls.
